Since 2005, the Center has provided high quality education and training to entrepreneurs at all stages of business. With the support of the SBA Women's Business Center Award in 2016, CWE expanded its programming to offer free one-on-one business counseling and technical assistance. CWE offers a suite of programs for early stage to established stage businesses including signature programs like Concept to Launch, Business of Child Care, Business Planning and Capital Readiness, Membership Program and Voices of Business Speaker Series. CWE's programs and services are structured to meet the needs of the regional communities and are offered at no or minimal cost to the participants. CWE serves entrepreneurs within the 11 counties surrounding Pittsburgh, PA.

CWE events and services are available to all.



Since receiving the SBA Women's Business Center award in 2016 the Center has offered 691 training programs from April 2016 through September 2025, to train entrepreneurs to start, manage and expand their businesses. Through these programs, CWE has served over 17,400 entrepreneurs with 2,200 training hours. **CWE was awarded the SBA Women Business Center of the Year Award in 2018.**
