Graduate & Gateway Housing

Chatham University and the Office of Residence Life are excited to offer our graduate and gateway students on-campus housing options that provide an environment conducive to your academic pursuits and career goals! These options provide residents with a quiet and courteous space that supports your learning.

Chatham University maintains four affordable housing options for graduate and Gateway students that are conveniently located on the lower half of the Shadyside Campus and one on Eden Hall Campus. Residents of graduate housing have easy access to campus activities, services, and resources as well as convenient access to the surrounding neighborhood and city at large.

Features and amenities

While each of the housing options have unique features and amenities, graduate and Gateway housing options offer the following amenities:

- Ten-month academic year leases (two terms of five months each), with an optional summer extension for June and July if possible.
- Water, heat, electricity, garbage/recycling, and access to both Wi-Fi & data ports are included in the housing charges.
- Kitchens in the Shadyside apartment complexes all have a full-size range, oven, and refrigerator,
- Closet and cabinet space in each apartment.
- Laundry facilities located in each building; free for residents.
- Most apartments are carpeted. Chung is a mixture of carpet and laminated flooring. Pelletreau and Hicks have some spaces with hardwood floors. Orchard Hall is tile flooring.
- The Duplex, Hicks, Haber, and Orchard Hall have air conditioning.
- Secure ID card access to each building.
- Regular patrol by Chatham University Public Safety at the Shadyside Campus.
- 24-Hour emergency support by the Office of Residence Life and Chatham Public Safety.

- Several Port Authority bus routes run along Fifth Avenue and have stops near each apartment building. All Chatham students ride public transportation free with a Chatham Student ID.
- All students can ride the free shuttle between Eden Hall and Shadyside campuses Monday-Friday.

Who can I live with?

Graduate and Gateway students may choose to live alone or with roommates (other Chatham graduate or Gateway students or non-Chatham affiliates). Students who wish to live with others are responsible for making those arrangements, and for notifying the Office of Residence Life. All residents are required to adhere to occupancy restriction listed in the housing application and provided by the Office of Residence Life.

Non-Chatham affiliates are required to sign the apartment lease and are then given an Associate ID Card that provides them entry to their building. If your roommate is not a student at Chatham University, your student account will be charged with the full housing cost for each term and you will be responsible for determining payment between you and your roommate.

How do I apply for housing?

Students apply for housing through the the housing portal located on myChatham > myTools > Student Housing. During the application process, students are required to submit a \$150.00 Housing Deposit utilizing a credit card (individuals who can't pay with credit card must e-mail reslife@chatham.edu to make arrangements to submit payment by check or cash before starting the application process).

Specific instructions on how to apply can be found at chatham.edu > Student Housing Experience > Housing & Dining > Graduate Housing. The priority consideration deadline is March 19, 2021.

Am I required to have a meal plan?

Graduate and Gateway students that live on **Shadyside Campus** are not required to purchase a meal plan because each apartment provides an adequate kitchen for each tenant. However, a resident in graduate housing may purchase a meal plan for each term. Meal plans can be purchased on my.Chatham.edu. Residents living in Orchard Hall on the Eden Hall Campus are required to purchase one of the multiple meal plans offered by Chatham.

Where can I park?

Shadyside Campus

Chatham University provides parking at each of the Shadyside Campus graduate apartment complexes with the exception of the Duplex at Maryland Ave. Parking in each complex is open and there are no

assigned spaces. Additional parking is available on the upper portion of campus. Residents can register and pay for a parking permit via my.Chatham.edu by submitting the online parking permit application. Public Safety manages parking and will process your application and issue your permit.

Residents of the Duplex at Maryland Ave. can park on Maryland Avenue with a Pittsburgh Parking Authority permit

Please note that all visitors should park on upper campus as the apartment complex lots are permit parking only. Due to the limited number of spaces available, we intend for the parking lots to be used by residents only. Parking violations will result in a parking ticket issued by Public Safety.

Eden Hall Campus

As a laboratory of sustainable living, parking at Eden Hall Campus is concentrated in a couple of areas and community members are encouraged to walk or bike within campus. Parking for residents is available at the North Parking lot across from Orchard Hall and at each of the rental property locations. There is limited, day-use parking at the Lodge. The parking spaces at the Solar Array near the Esther Barazzone Center (EBC) are used for short-term visitor parking and special vehicles. Overnight parking is only available at the North Lot and general parking is prohibited in other areas, including behind the EBC, near Orchard Hall or along Ridge Road. All residents will receive a parking permit upon move in but must submit registration information.

Chung Apartments

Haber Apartments

Haber consists of seven furnished, one and two-bedroom apartments. These contemporary style apartments provide ample living space and are located across the street from the Shadyside Campus.



Hicks Estate, Annex, and Carriage House

5812 Fifth Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15232



Pelletreau Apartments
