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PLACEMENT TESTING 2016

In order to ensure academic success during your studies at Chatham University, we will evaluate your academic preparedness and use academic placement testing to help make sure you begin coursework at a level that is right for you. This means your SAT/ACT scores will place you into your Math and/or English coursework levels.

If you would like to test out of the levels in which you have been placed, you must "opt in" to take the appropriate placement exam(s) in order to move up or out of the level in which you have been placed. Chatham offers two placement exams for new students: The Math Placement Test and the English Placement Test. These tests are offered during New Student Registration.

Math Placement:

The table below shows the typical math levels where placement will occur given SAT/ACT math scores:

Calculus II (MTH152) An available option for students who have already taken Calculus I and are ready to move on. Consult with your advisor.

If you believe you should have been placed into a higher level math course, you have the option to take a math placement test on your registration day.

- You must be deposited at least 24 hours in advance of placement testing.
- The math test will be conducted on Moodle, Chatham's online course platform.
- The math exam format will be multiple choice.

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English Placement:

Course (first year):	COR491 (1 credit)	

Supplemental Instruction in Writing at Chatham University is designed to promote academic success by providing support and tutoring in writing for first-year and transfer students. Supplemental Instruction focuses on the development of writing skills necessary for successful completion of Chatham's first year college level writing course, ENG 105 and other writing intensive courses across the University's curriculum. This additional one on one tutoring in writing is a unique opportunity for our students to strengthen their writing skills as they transition and integrate to academic life at Chatham.

Transfer students have the option to take CORE491-section 4 if they would like additional writing support.

Supplemental Instruction in Writing sessions are scheduled with your availability in mind so as to occur at convenient times that work with your other commitments. You will establish your meeting time between you and your writing tutor based on your schedule needs.

If you believe you do not need Supplemental Instruction in Writing, you will have the option to take the English placement test on your registration day or during New Student Orientation in August.

- You must be deposited at least 24 hours in advance of arrival.
- English placement test will be conducted on Moodle, Chatham's online course platform.
- The English exam format will be multiple choice, reading comprehension with short response, and short essay.
